Clerk had received an email informing members of the County Councils proposed intentions to repair the bridge in Pontsian during the school summer holidays as the road would need to be closed.

4) Funding Applications:

Gardening Festival

Cllr Keith Evans declared his interest in the following application for funding and reminded the Council of his dispensation to speak and vote on the matter. Application for funding was received from Llandysul a Pontyweli Ymlaen asking for a donation of £500 to help with funding the Gardening Weekend from the 15-19 of February 2023. It was decided to donate the requested amount.

5) Matters for Discussion

Llandysul Children's Play area

A sub-committee had been established by the Chairman Matt Adams supported by Cllrs Mike Hotson, Sioned Thomas, Elen Grantham that had not yet met. A report to be received by the next meeting. Cllr Elen Grantham also requested a copy of the latest Rospa Report. Cllr Keith Evans advised that funding could possibly be available from the County Council/Welsh Government or Ceredigion Community Grant.

Vacant Seat

A letter of application had been received for the vacant seat for the Llandysul Town Ward by Mr R Winter. It was decided to invite him to the next meeting and thank him for his interest.

Repair and Maintenance

A tender document had been prepared for specified Maintenance work and specification for brush cutting areas. A member of the public had written to the Council asking if we could delay the second cut to the end of September. It was decided to incorporate this into the specification.

Planting Flower troughs in Llandysul

Councillor Andrew Howell had provided a written report on planting in Llandysul. It

Llandysul

Esboniodd Cyng Peter Evans bod y tyllau a nodwyd ym Mharc yr Ynn wedi cael eu llenwi. Mynegodd yr angen i chwynnu'r palmentydd o'r Hen Ysgol Gynradd i fyny i Barc yr Ynn. Roedd preswylwyr niferus wedi mynegi eu pryder ynghylch hen gaeau chwarae Ysgol Dyffryn Teifi gan bod pobl yn gadael eu cŵn yn rhydd yno, gan arwain at faw cŵn ac ysbwriel yn y cae. Bydd y clerwr yn cysylltu â'r Cyngor Sir am y materion a godwyd.

Capel Dewi

Mynegwyd pryder gan Gyng Douglas Davies am gyflwr y ffordd rhwng Llanfihangel-ar-arth a Chapel Dewi o ganlyniad i dirlithriadau pellach. Roedd sefyllfa debyg wedi codi eto gyda'r ffordd uwch ben Dôl Wallter, a oedd wedi erydu unwaith eto. Bydd y clerwr yn ysgrifennu i'r Cyngor Sir ar fyrder.

Esboniodd Cyng Davies ymhellach bod colyn wedi torri ar yr Hysbysfwrdd yng Nghapel Dewi. Bydd y clerwr yn trefnu bod hwn yn cael ei drwsio.

Roedd preswylwyr o gwmpas Derlwyn yn anfodlon iawn o hyd am y diffyg ymgynghori ynghylch y cam o waredu'r blwch postio yn eu cymuned. Bydd y clerwr yn cysylltu â'r Post Brenhinol a'n Haelod Seneddol, Ben Lake, nad oedd wedi dod yn ôl atom am y mater.

was decided to ask Mr Richard Bramley of Farmyard Nurseries if he could undertake the work needed this year for a fee. It was also decided that Cllr Andrew Howell assisted by Cllr Keith Evans prepare a draft planting specification to go out to tender for 2024. To maintain the look of the planting a draft specification would also be required regarding the control of weeds. A watering specification is already in place.

Urgent Ward Matters

Pontsian

Cllr Gethin Jones explained that volunteers in the village intended planting shrubs / flowers next to the bus shelter in Pontsian. It was decided that Cllr Gethin Jones obtains invoices for the plant's etc to enable the Community Council to cover the cost.

Llandysul

Cllr Peter Evans explained that the identified potholes at Parc yr Ynn had been resurfaced. He expressed the need for weeding pavements from the Old Primary School up to Parc yr Ynn.

Numerous residents had expressed their concern about the old Ysgol Dyffryn Teifi playing fields as people were letting their dogs loose resulting in dog fouling and dumping rubbish in the field. The clerk to contact the County Council regarding the matters raised.

Capel Dewi

Cllr Douglas Davies expressed his concern that the integrity of the road between Llanfihangel ar Arth and Capel Dewi due to further landslips. A similar situation had also arisen again with the highway above Dol Wallter which had eroded again. The clerk to urgently write to the County Council.

Cllr Davies further explained that a hinge had broken on the

Noticeboard in Capel Dewi. The clerk to arrange for this to be repaired.

Residents around Derlwyn were still very unhappy about the lack of consultation with the removal of the post-box in their community. The clerk to contact Royal Mail

Dywedodd Cyng Evans bod y Cyngor Sir yn gosod dau bwynt gwefru trydanol yn y maes parcio ar hyn o bryd.

Report by County Councillors

Cllr Keith Evans had emailed full and detailed account of his County Council and community activities during the past month to all Councillors.

Cllr Maldwyn Lewis wished to inform Councillors of a surgery that would be held at the Family Centre by Citizens Advice. Date to be confirmed.

He advised that the case for retaining free parking in Llandysul Car-park for 2023/24 had received the support of the scrutiny committee which had been subsequently accepted and endorsed by Cabinet. The final decision would be made by Full Council at its 2nd March meeting.

Cllr Keith Evans thanked Cllr Lewis for endorsing his proposal for the continued free parking at the scrutiny meeting.

Cllr Evans advised that the County Council was in the process of installing two electrical charging points at the carpark.

He reminded the Community Council of the e-mail which had been circulated regarding conditions regarding street closure for events. Cllr Evans also drew attention to the reduced service that could be expected from the Council in terms of street cleaning.

He went on to explain that matters were proceeding with regards to the marketing grant which had materialised through the relationship with Cynnal y Cardi, Llandysul Pont-Tyweli Ymlaen and the Community Council.
